Hello,

I'm an Oregon falconer and hunter. I have recently heard about the proposed Stockade Block management plan which would close out 230,000 acres of this land to public hunting. I am very distressed about this proposal, and wish to voice my opposition. Hunters' options are limited as it is and many of us cannot afford to privately lease hunting land--public land is the only real opportunity I and my family have for hunting ground. We are subsistence hunters and live as much as possible from what we harvest from the wild, and are increasingly more dependent on wild-harvested foods in these economic times. I only rarely have an opportunity to travel to eastern Oregon but do so about three times a year specifically for hunting. Access to public land means a very great deal to me and my family. I oppose closing these lands to public hunting.
