**Subject:** Stockade Block Plan Comments

I would like to voice my strong OPPOSITION to the drafted Stockade Block Area Management Plan. I oppose particularly the proposal to offer leased hunting rights instead of public access. The Land Board's mission of utilizing the land to provide the greatest good for the people of the State is achieved more by allowing public access than it would be by collecting meager fees for exclusive hunting leases. Though the benefit of having public access is not monetary, it is a much larger benefit I'm sure. The area would not generate fees sufficient to make up for the loss of public access to this land. The draft plan states that the market for such a revenue source is unknown. In my opinion the market is extremely meager; there is strong competition from neighboring states that manage and produce much higher quality big game hunting. It would not provide greater good than continuing to allow public access.
